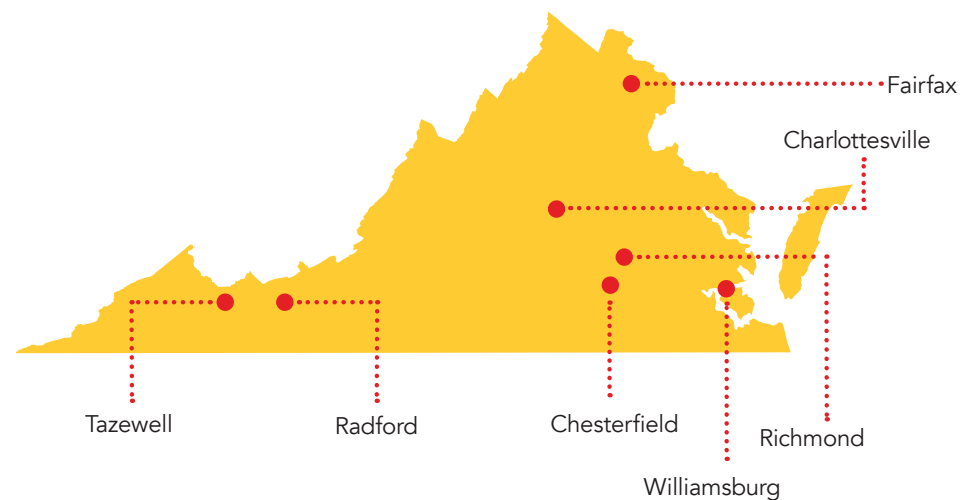

With your support, Keith now has a place of his own and bright plans for his future.

In last year's annual report, we highlighted how your support helped Keith earn his GED. We thought you would like an update on Keith's progress. As a reminder, Keith came to Gateway three years ago. He had dropped out of high school in the 11th grade, and due to his mental illness, he found himself in a state hospital at age 20 with no high school diploma and very little freedom. Keith said, "I started GED classes while I was in the hospital. One day when my mom was driving me back to the hospital after taking a test, we were stuck in traffic and I was late by a few minutes. I even called and did everything I could but when I returned, I lost all of my privileges for six months. My new goal was to be discharged from the hospital and earn my GED."

Keith credits Gateway with teaching him to live independently, make healthy choices, and generally become more social.

After six years in the state hospital, Keith was ready to be discharged, but he still did not have his GED. After visiting the picturesque Gateway campus and comparing that to the state hospital, he said, "This is where I want to be."

As we shared in the last annual report, Keith progressed quickly at Gateway,

passed his GED, and set his sights on obtaining his learner's permit to begin learning how to drive. Now, a year later, we are thrilled to tell you that Keith continues to excel! He said, "I'm making my time here at Gateway useful," We wholeheartedly agree! Keith has moved off of Gateway's campus and into a house in the community. In spring 2020, he will continue his studies at the John Tyler Community College where he plans to major in Visual Arts.

Keith credits Gateway for teaching him to live independently, make healthy choices, and become more social. "I have my own place and I'm proud of that," he

said. "Now, I don't take anything for granted. I have been in dark places. I can't change what happened, but now...I feel happy and enjoy my time." Keith appreciates Gateway's self-paced, person-centered programming. "Getting to visit with friends and family at my leisure is something I don't take for granted. Anyone that has been through what I have would understand." And about that driver's license? Keith is so excited to say, he will be driving himself to college!

complete the FASFA application. He also thanks Gateway for having "the best occupational therapist in the world" who accompanied him to the college's orientation, giving him confidence to meet with a college advisor and get his questions answered. Fitzi is primed for success!

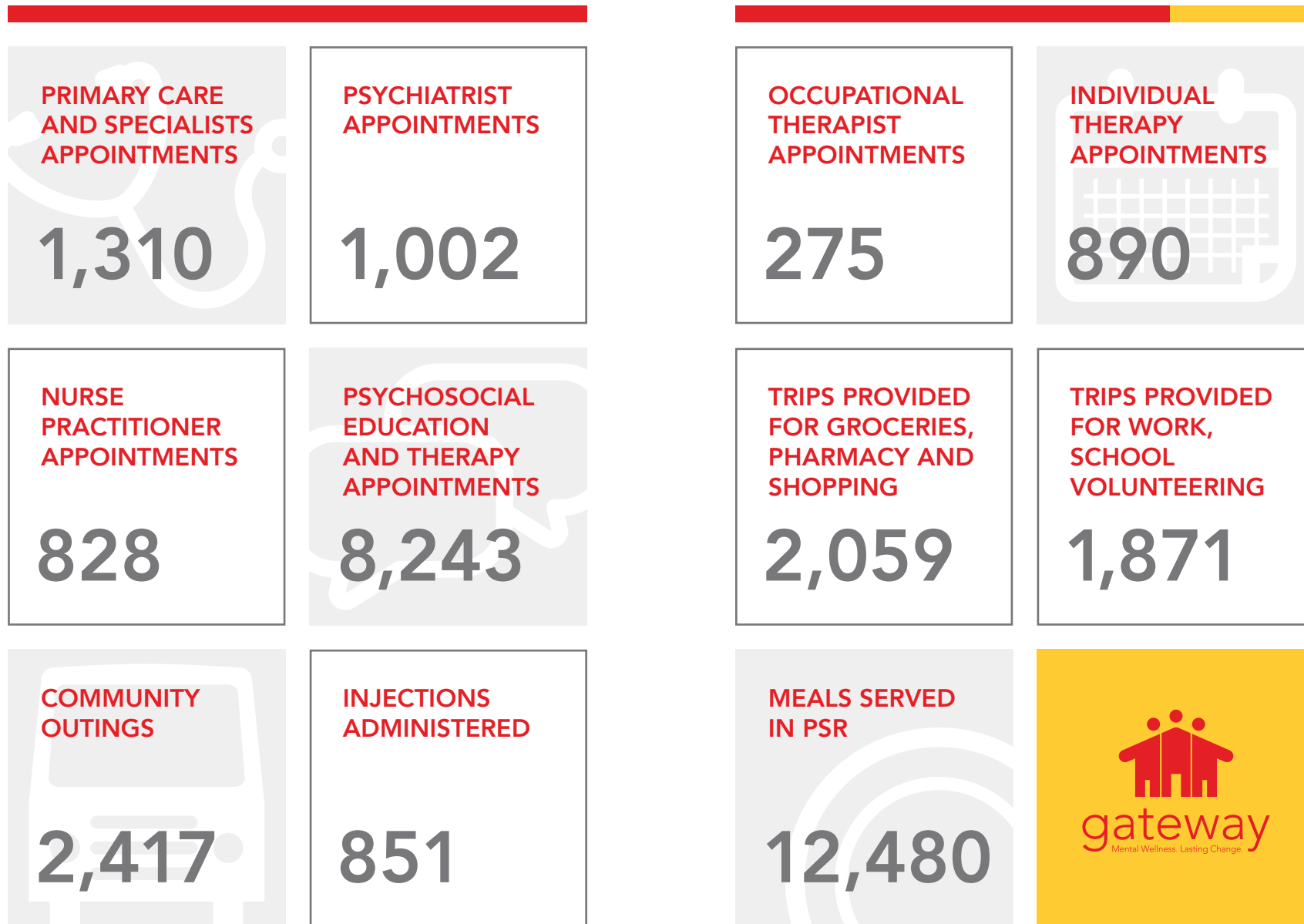

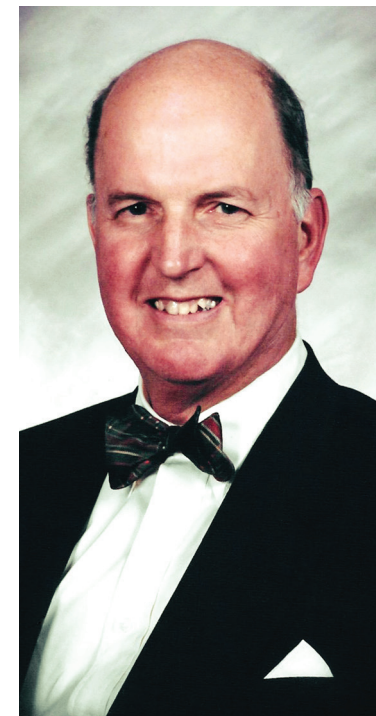
